**Assignment Title : Construction Supervision Consultancy Services for supervising the
TNRSP II road upgradation works under Engineering
Procurement and Construction (EPC) contracting mode**

1. The Government of India has applied for financing from the World Bank towards the cost of the **Tamil Nadu Road Sector Project – II (TNRSP II)**.
2. The consulting services (“the Services”) include supervising the TNRSP II road upgradation (Balance works) under Engineering, Procurement and Construction (EPC) contracting mode. The road length is about 35.80 Km. The works will be taken up in suitable construction contract packages spread throughout the state of Tamil Nadu. One consultancy contract is envisaged to supervise the construction contracts for a total length of about 35.80 Km (Balance work).The road work involves upgradation of existing road to 2 Lane + Paved shoulder and 4 Lane + paved shoulder. Required major bridges, minor bridges, ROBs, culverts are to be constructed and reconstructed. The work contract also involves 5 years maintenance after the completion of construction. Implementing Environment management measures are also a part of the construction contracts. Road safety is an integral part of the DPR design. The Consultant shall act as ‘Supervision Consultant’ and perform the duties and obligations of the “Engineer” in the execution of the works. The consultancy services are to be completed within a period of about 30 months.
3. The Project Director, Tamil Nadu Road Sector Project II, for and on behalf of the Governor of State of Tamil Nadu, now invites, eligible consulting firms (“Consultants”) to indicate their interest in providing the Services. Interested Consultants should provide information demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the Services.

4. The shortlisting criteria are:

- i. Should have successfully completed at least **one** similar work (involving all the components of the services as briefed in para 2 above including experience /exposure in supervision of Balance work) for a road length of not less than **35.00 km or 2 similar works of road length not less than 20 km in the last 10 years.**
- ii. Should have successfully completed atleast one consulting service works to the tune of **Rs.6 Crores (total) for the above project in Cl.4 (i).**
- iii. The completed similar works should have been performed either for Government of India or similar country or Tamil Nadu or other states of India or similar country or for organization of State / Central Government or for projects funded by multilateral agencies like World Bank, Asian Development Bank or bilateral agencies like Japan International Co-operation Agency anywhere.
- iv. Shall be in a position to deploy required qualified key personnel.

5. The attention of interested Consultants is drawn to paragraph 1.9 of the World Bank's Guidelines: Selection and Employment of Consultants [under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits & Grants] by World Bank Borrowers January 2011("Consultant Guidelines"), setting forth the World Bank's policy on conflict of interest. In addition please refer to the following specific information on conflict of interest related to this assignment.

"The Consultant engaged for project preparation consultancy services for any of the package/ roads is not eligible to apply for the Supervision Consultancy/ Independent Engineer/ Monitoring Consultancy Services for the same package/ roads during implementations."

6. Consultants may associate with other firms in the form of a joint venture or a consortium or a subconsultancy to enhance their qualifications.

8. A Consultant will be selected in accordance with the Consultant Guidelines.

BACKGROUND NOTE

TAMIL NADU ROAD SECTOR PROJECT II

Construction Supervision Consultancy Services for supervising the upgrading Vridhachalam - Parangipettai Road (SH70) Km 0/000 to Km 35/800 (Balance works) under Engineering, Procurement and Construction (EPC) contracting mode

1. The Government of Tamil Nadu (GoTN) under Tamil Nadu Road Sector Project II (TNRSP II) have taken various road improvement work and among them this said upgradation work is for a length of about 35.80 Km.
2. The work was awarded to a contractor in 2014 and subsequently terminated on 2018. The rebid for the balance works is in progress.
3. It is proposed to engage a Supervision Consultant for the supervising the upgradation of above balance work.
4. The GoTN now invites Expression Of Interest (EOI) applications from eligible consultants to provide for carrying out the supervision consultancy services.

5. The main work includes, the construction of balance works including widening from existing 2 lane to 2 lane paved shoulder/ 4 lane paved shoulder and pavement strengthening with all required drainage facility, road furniture and accessories and maintenance of entire road length of 35.80Km. Construction / Reconstruction of culverts, bridges etc., new alignments / re-alignments wherever required.

6. SCOPE OF SERVICES IN BRIEF:

The main tasks of the consultancy services will be but not limited to the supervision following:

- (a) Carryout the review of contract documents, engineering proposals of the Contractor and to issue time to time clearances for carrying out the work.
- (b) Carry out the day to day supervision of construction activities, quality control, cost and time control, certification of payments etc.

- (c) Ensure implementation of EMP measures envisaged under the work contracts.
- (d) Project monitoring and reporting to the client.
- (e) Ensure implementation of Road Safety measures.
- (f) To implement the contract between the employer and the contractor in letter as spirit.
